### Requirements & Notes (including COVID-19 Changes due to the pandemic emergency are reflected)

CANV's Food Bank. Receive an allotment of food from one of the pantry locations every 30 days. In order to be eligible an individual or household must reside in the Napa County (geographical area being served). One person per household must provide two forms of ID, one with current address and one with birthdate.

The United States Department of Agriculture contracts with CANV's Food Bank to administer 8 to 10 food staples to low-income Napa County residents once a month. NOTE – Napa Residents may only access one of the two sites. (USDA) commodities for distribution to eligible individuals and households within their respective service areas. In order to be eligible for USDA commodities, an individual or household must reside in the geographical area being served and meet established income guidelines.

**Meals on Wheels for Seniors** Application Required visit website [www.canv.org](http://www.canv.org) and download the application (English or Spanish). Please complete the application and send back. Home delivered meals will begin the following delivery day upon receipt of completed application. Please be advised our delivery days are Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Clients will receive 2 lunch meals on Monday, 2 lunch meals and 1 snack bag on Wednesday, and 1 lunch meal and 1 snack bag on Friday. Return to congregate settings will resume soon.

Senior Brown Bag Program -Enables seniors age 60 or older to remain independent as long as possible by giving them a "Brown Bag" with approximately 10 to 14 food items twice a month. Items may include fresh fruit, canned vegetables, oatmeal, bottled beverages, pasta and canned meat. Seniors pick up Brown Bags from 11 sites throughout Napa County, or volunteer drivers deliver food to those who are infirm or disabled. Application Required
