MIDDLE SCHOOL COUNSELOR

St. Helena Unified School District is accepting applications for a counselor (1.0 FTE) at the RLS Middle School beginning in the 2023-24 school year. This position supports grade levels 6th-8th.

Job Duties: Provides individual and group counseling and guidance for secondary students at one or more school sites, liaison to community and supplemental professional services, and in-service support to teachers and staff. Counsel students, develop and maintain master schedule, academic guidance, testing, graduation, special education referrals and placement, parental and behavior referrals. The counselor also requires the ability to facilitate student support services such as student assistance, at-risk behavior intervention and SARB.

Qualifications: California Pupil Personnel Credential authorizing school counseling. Requires a valid driver's license. Teaching experience desirable. **Bilingual (Spanish) is highly preferred.**
