



## St. Helena Unified School District COVID Guidelines Effective January 10, 2022

### Student is COVID positive Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated Symptomatic or Asymptomatic

- 5 days isolation **AND**
- Fever free without the use of fever-reducing medication **AND**
- Symptoms improving **AND**
- Negative Rapid Antigen Test result on or after day 5
- If a rapid antigen test is not available, then isolation is 10 days.

### Student is Symptomatic Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated

- 5-day quarantine may come back sooner with:
  - Negative PCR or Rapid Antigen Test **OR**
  - Doctor note stating non-COVID illness

### Student is Exposed Outside of School Asymptomatic Vaccinated

- No quarantine

### Student is Exposed Outside of School Asymptomatic Unvaccinated

- Quarantine (standard) at home- no extracurriculars
  - Test on day 5 at outside laboratory return to school on day 8 if negative **AND** remains asymptomatic.
  - If student does not test, they must stay home for 10 days

### Student is Exposed At School Asymptomatic Unvaccinated

- Quarantine (modified) attend at school – no extracurriculars
  - The district will test twice a week at school.
    - If negative student will continue in school
    - If positive a confirmatory test will be conducted, and student will be sent home for a 5-day isolation
      - Test on day 5 if negative, quarantine ends day 8
  - If parent does **not** consent to in school testing the student will be sent home for standard quarantine.
- Monitor for symptoms for a full 14 days, if ANY symptoms present, student starts a 5-day quarantine (see SYMPTOMATIC).
